Sticker Remover Aufkleber Entferner

Characteristics :

- Residue-free peeling off
- Extra strong for labels and adhesives
- Also for ink, oil, grease and soot

Action :

Efficient combination of active ingredients for gentle peeling off and total removal of self-adhesive and strongly adherent stickers, labels and adhesive residues.

Also for removing ink, greasy and oily contamination, tar and soot

Scope of application :

For easy removal of adhesive labels, stickers, labels, adhesive tapes and other sticky residues. Also to facilitate dissolution of ink, grease, oil, tar and soot. Suitable for surfaces such as glass, plastic, wood, PVC, stone and ceramic.

Application :

Soak dry cloth with the sticker remover and apply onto the adhesive residue.

Let it soak in for a while and start removing the sticker at one corner. Following this, rub off the adhesive residues thoroughly and rinse using lots of water.

In the case of plastic labels, remove or scratch the top layer mechanically first thus allowing the remover to penetrate.

Use a soaked cloth for treating stains and always dissolve them by rubbing over them. Afterwards, remove any residues using an absorbent cloth.

Indications :

Prior to application, always test for surface compatibility on an inconspicuous area. Not suitable for certain plastics such as Perspex (acrylic glass). Apply the product on lacquered and sensitive surfaces only diluted 1:1 with detergent.
